 Ms. Pope reviewed the PPIC's Quarterly Financial Report for the Fiscal Year end June 30, 2023.

Old Business

• Port of Virginia Update:

Mr. Thomas Cross of the Port of Virginia provided an update on the Port's activities. Improvements to the Portsmouth Marine Terminal are approximately 40% complete to support Dominion Energy's Coastal Virginia Offshore Wind project. Wind turbine components are scheduled to begin arriving in October. Construction of terminal improvements at Norfolk International Terminal is underway. The Central Railyard project will provide additional capacity to port operations. The Port of Virginia has recently been named the second most efficient port in North America.

• STARBASE Victory:

Mr. Donahue presented a grant funding request from STARBASE Victory program in the amount of \$50,000 to provide funding support for the expansion of STEM program offerings within the Portsmouth Public Schools.

• Hampton Roads Workforce Council Briefing:

Mr. Whitney Lester, Senior Director of Talent Development and Mrs. Jacqueline Rondeau, Employment Engagement Manager with the Hampton Roads Workforce Council provided an overview of the Workforce Council's programs and services. There was discussion on the development of a talent pipeline to serve the region's industry employment demands.

3920, 3930 Burtons Point Rd.:

Mr. Donahue provided an update on planning activities for future development opportunities. Conceptual site layouts were presented that provided designs for accommodating industrial buildings on the properties.

NNSY South Gate Annex Update:

Mr. Donahue updated the board on the areas within the Norfolk Naval Shipyard's South Gate Annex that may be available for future economic development purposes. The Navy has identified an 3.5 acre portion of the property that is being considered for potential utilization for industrial activities. The Commissioners expressed a desire to tour the site.
